
NOCTI Assessment Export

How to do NOCTI Assessment Data Exports

The CTEIS NOCTI Assessment Export tool enables Building Reporters to export students in CIP Coded programs that are eligible for assessments provided by NOCTI.

Access NOCTI Assessment Export Tool

- · Log in to CTEIS, at www.cteis.com, using your MEIS Username and Password.
- From the Main menu, select Data Entry, and then select NOCTI Export. The NOCTI
 Assessment Export Tool page appears.



Run the NOCTI Assessment Export

1. Select a building to locate the programs eligible for NOCTE assessment in that building.



- A program list appears that shows you all the programs in your building for which students are eligible to take the assessment test. If you do not see a particular program in the list then please contact the CTEIS help desk. To see a list of programs eligible for NOCTI Assessments, see the Appendix.
- 3. Type the NOCTI site code that has been provided by NOCTI.
- 4. Click the **Generate NOCTI Export File** button to run the export. A file with all the students, in all the programs, under your building, who are eligible for NOCTI assessments is created.



5. Follow the instructions provided by the NOCTI Web Import Tool to complete the process.

When: NOCTI assessment data exports can be done as needed.

Who: Building Reporters do the NOCTI assessment data exports.
